In 2020 the disparities in maternal mortality rates between Black, Mixed Race and Asian women and their white counterparts in the UK were highlighted. Since then the statistics have remained much the same with Black women still 4 times more likely to die in pregnancy and birth than their white counterparts.... It is clear the gap is still yet to be closed.
